## International Conference on Viral Hepatitis March 26-27, 2012 New York Academy of Medicine

The [2<sup>nd</sup> International Conference on Viral Hepatitis](#) (ICVH 2012) will take place March 26-27 2012, at the [New York Academy of Medicine](#) in New York City. The [conference](#) is co-hosted by the Mount Sinai School of Medicine (New York) and the International Association of Physicians in AIDS Care (IAPAC), in partnership with the St. Stephen's AIDS Trust in London.

ICVH 2012's goal is to provide an international forum for the presentation and discussion of state-of-the-science hepatitis B virus (HBV) and hepatitis C virus (HCV) research and clinical perspectives in practicum. These include: defining parameters for treatment success; identifying and managing adherence and behavioral and clinical issues unique to patients with HBV and HCV; and evaluating current data related to new HBV and HCV treatment options and modalities.

The target audience is gastroenterologists, hepatologists, infectious disease (ID) and non-ID-specialized HIV-treating physicians, nurse-practitioners, physician-assistants, pharmacists and medical industry executives.
